The ornamental design for a hook and eye closure extender
for a brassiere, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 13 is a left side view thereof;

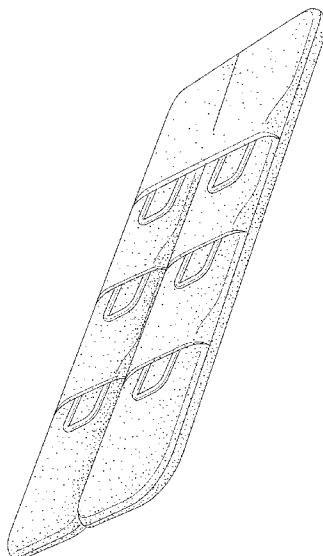
FIG. 14 is a right side view thereof;

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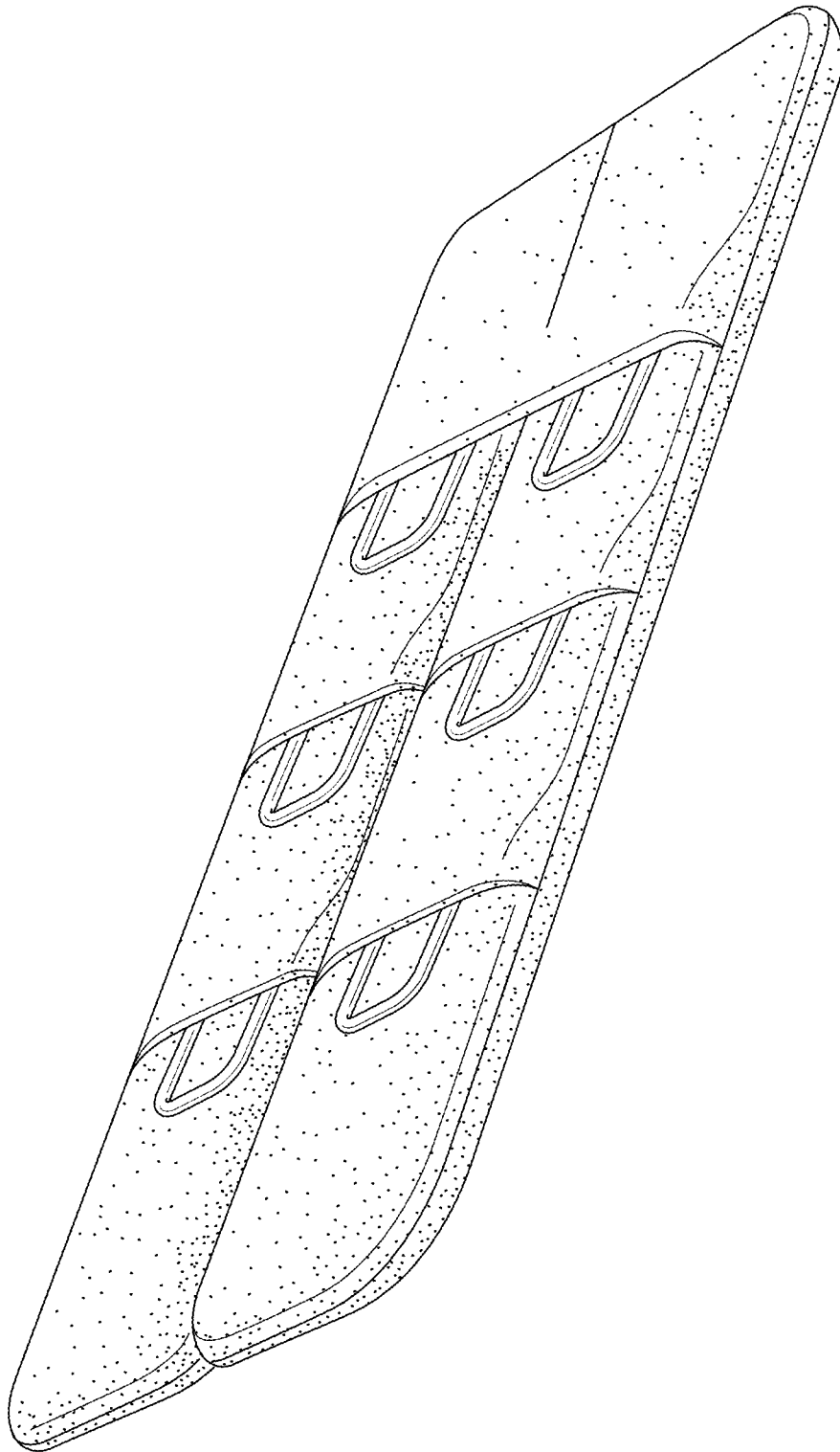

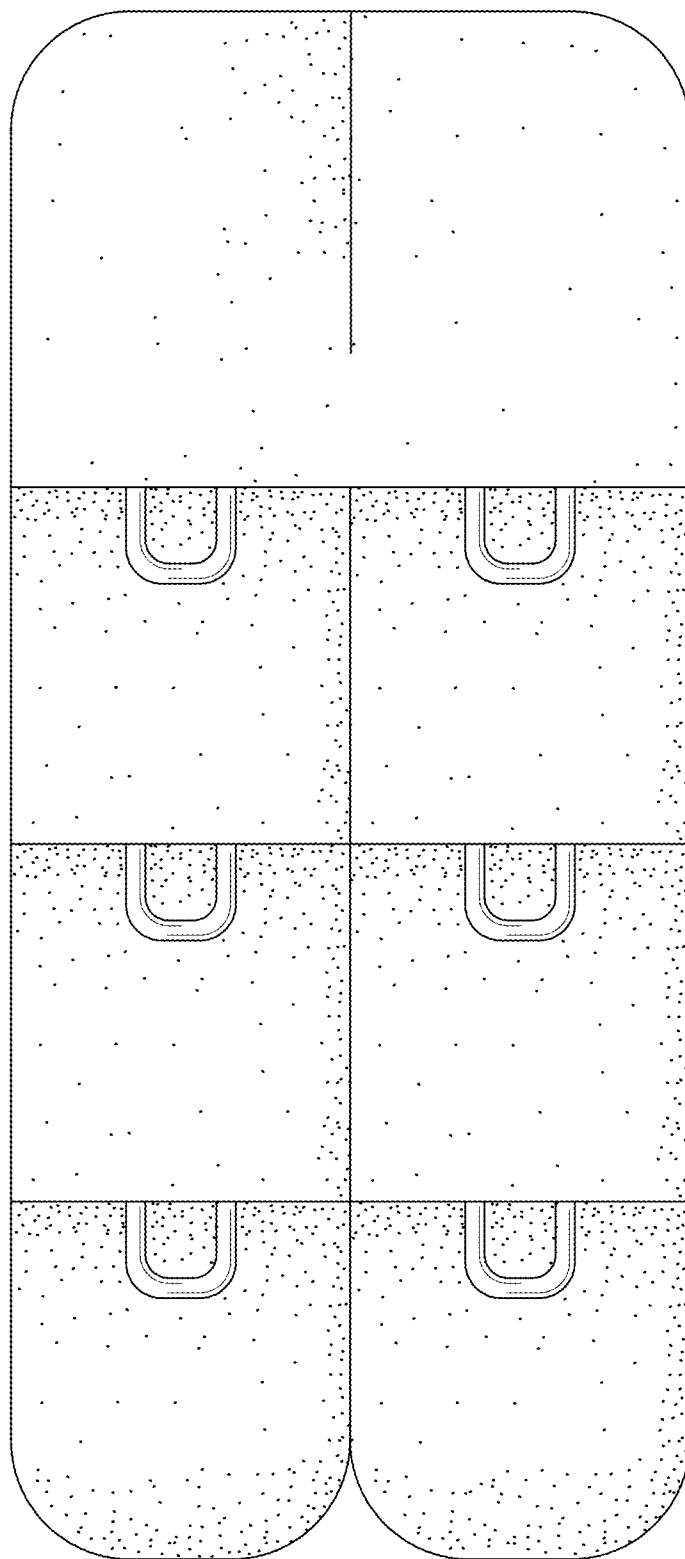

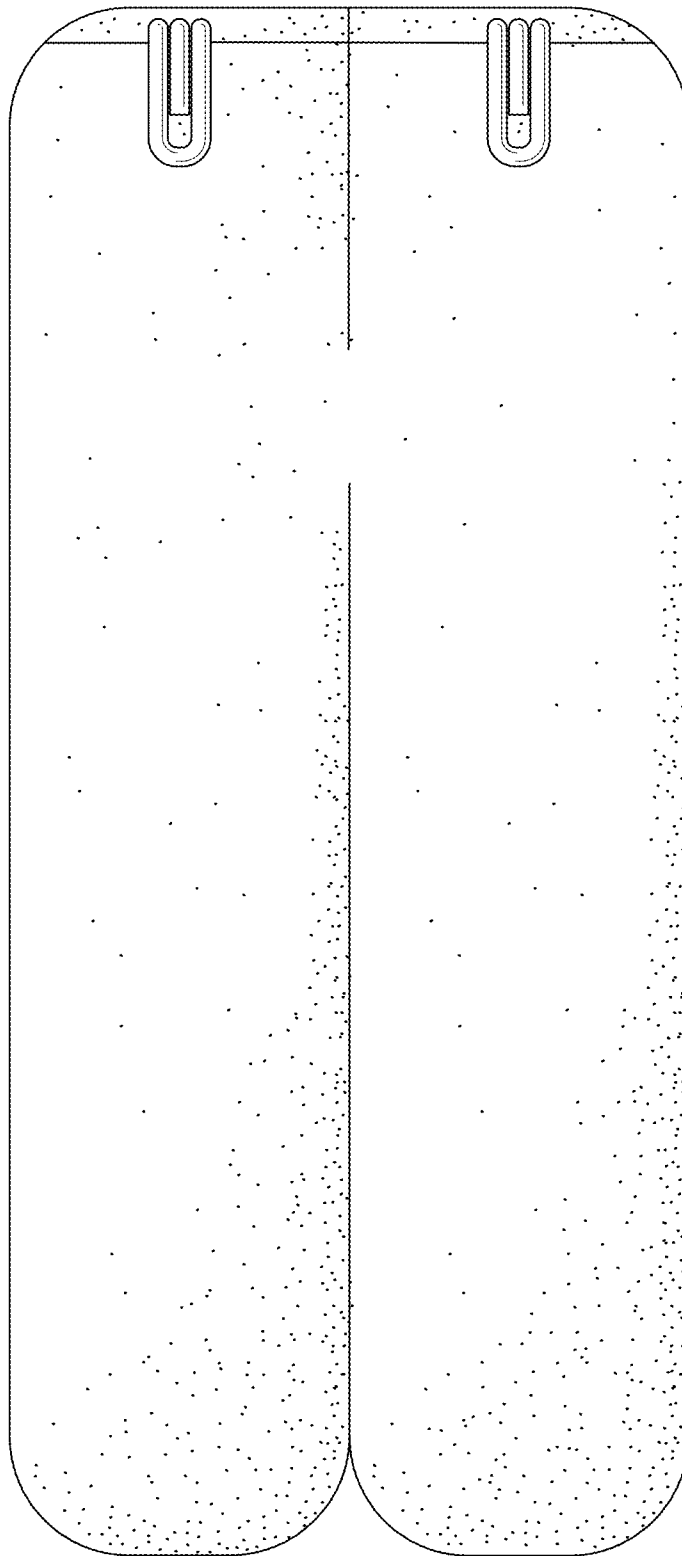

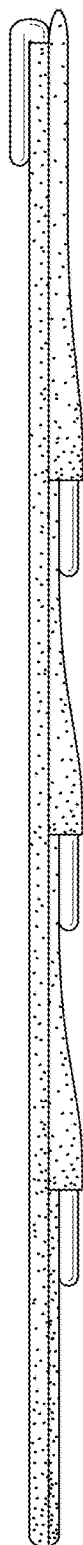

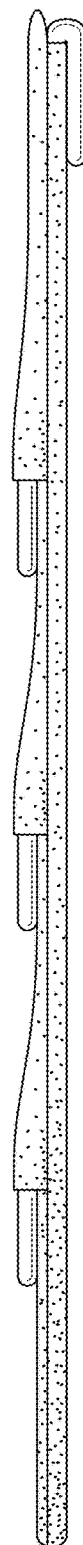

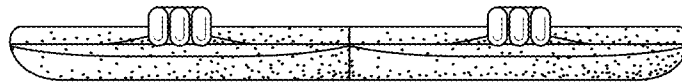

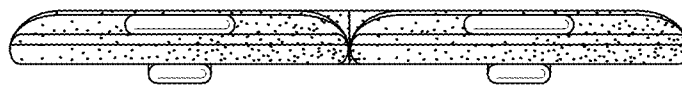

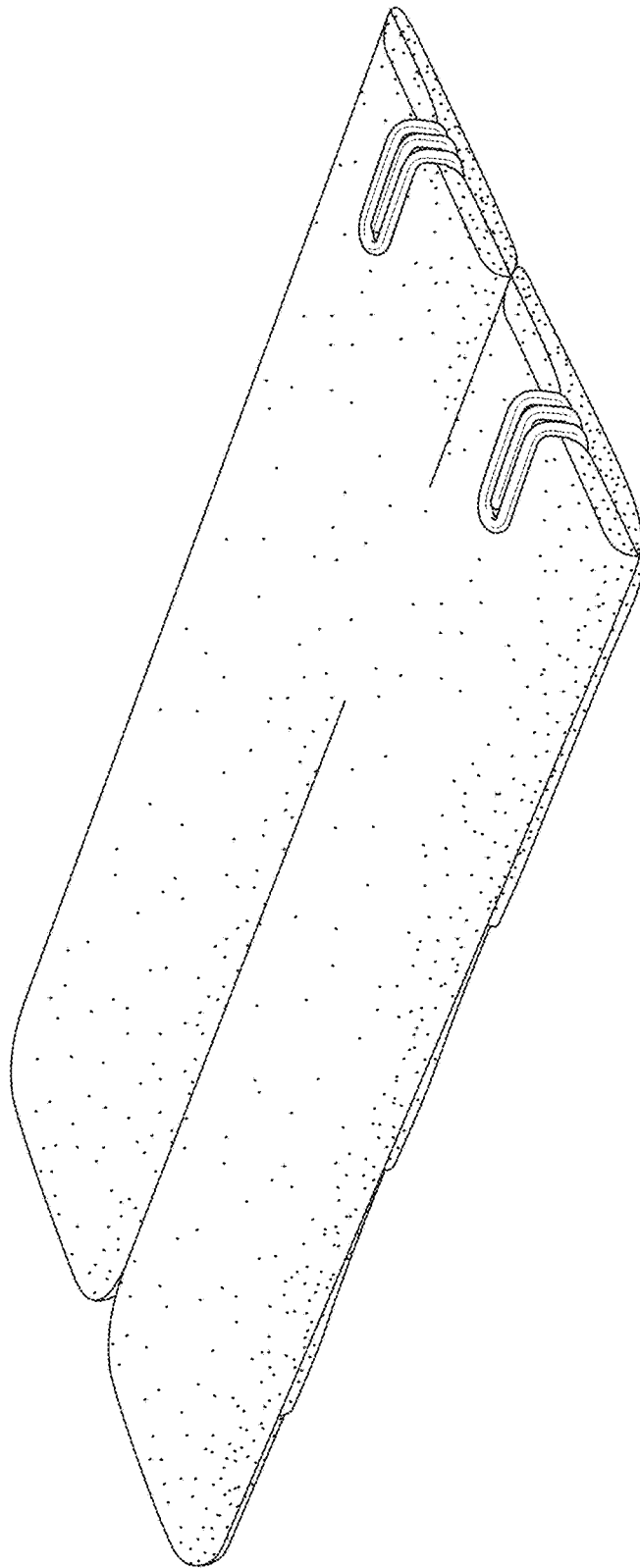

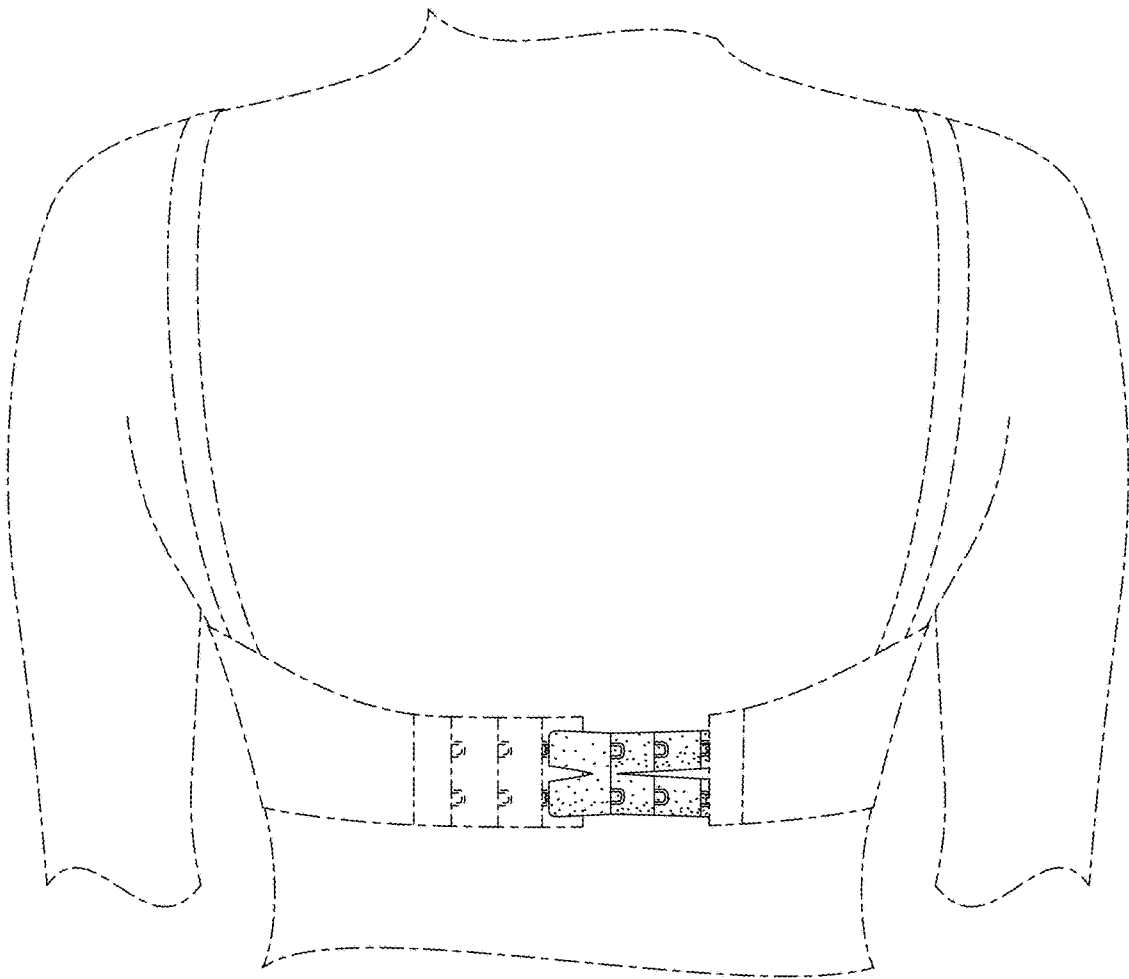

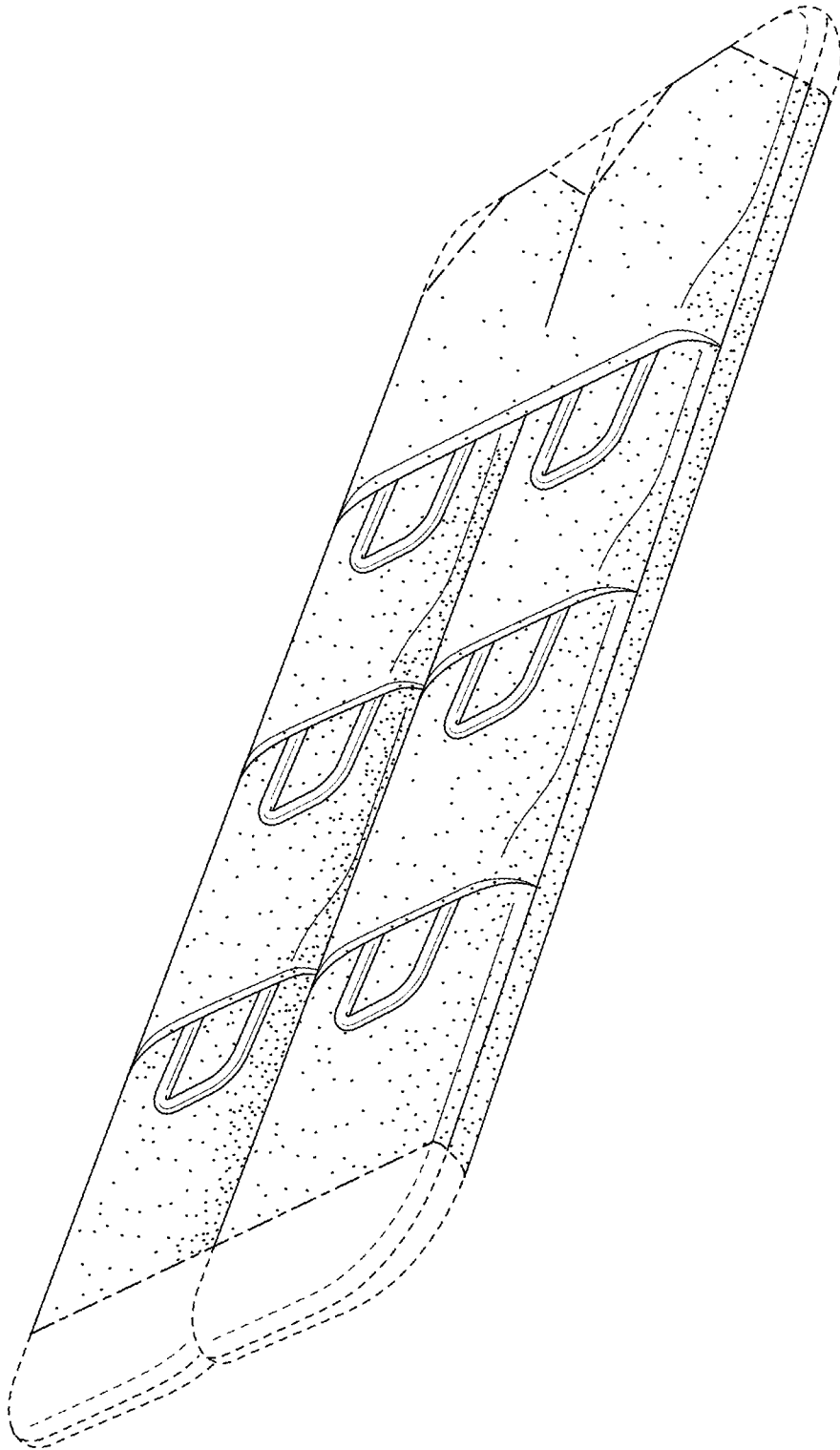

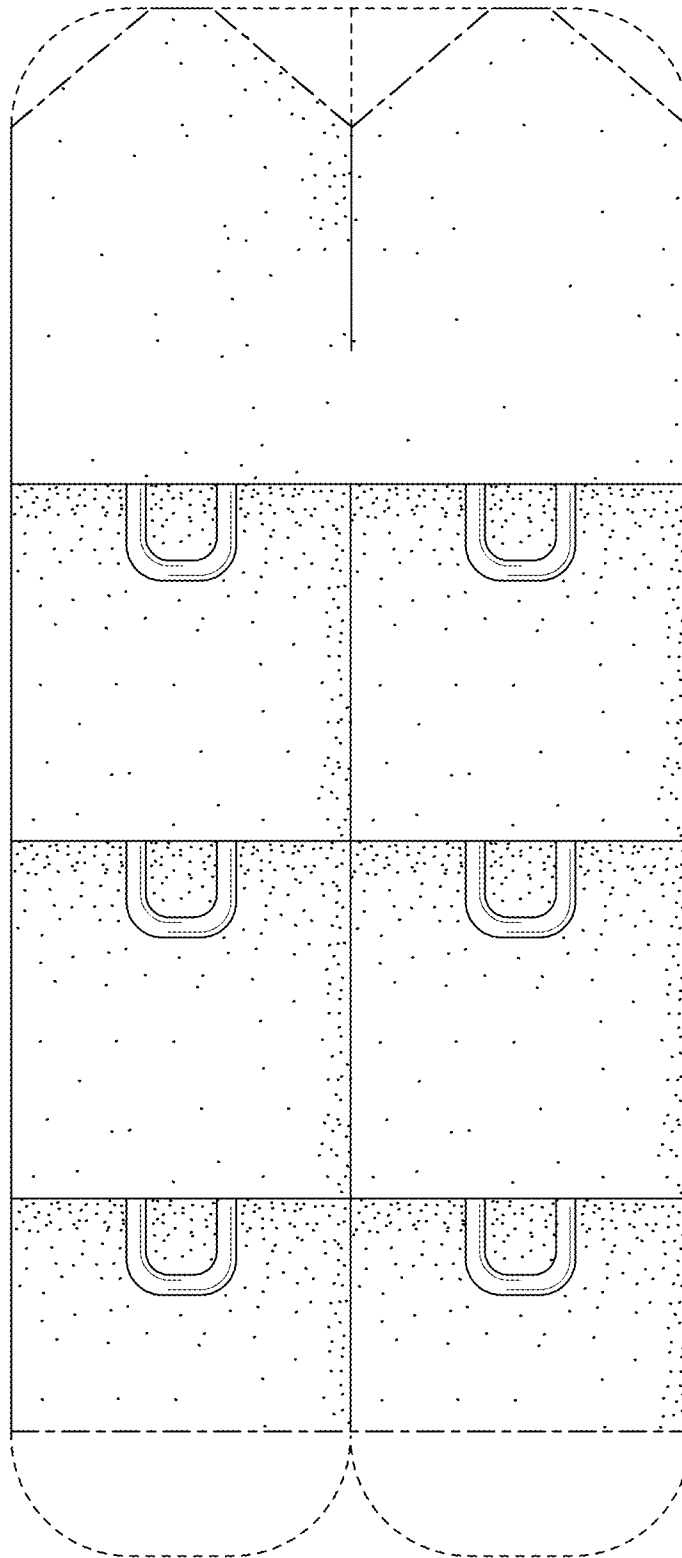

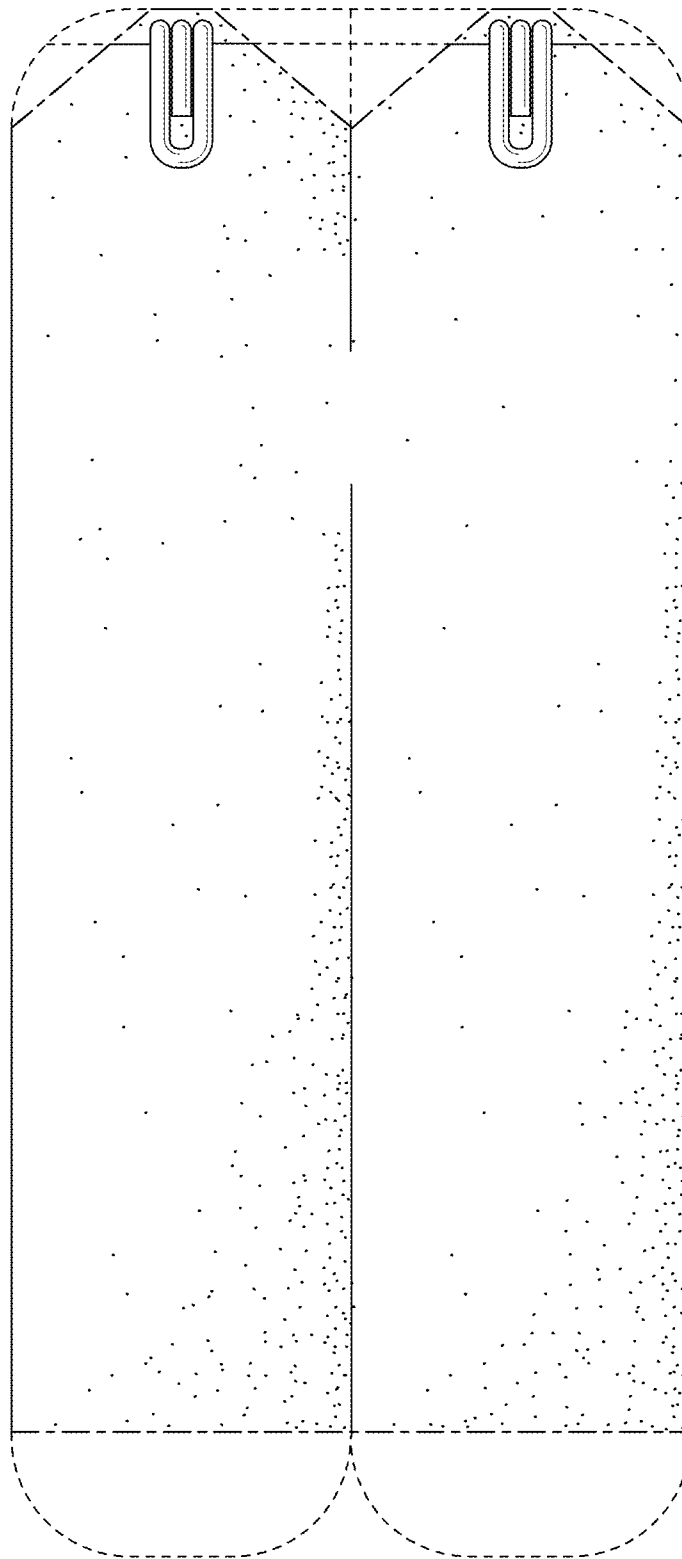

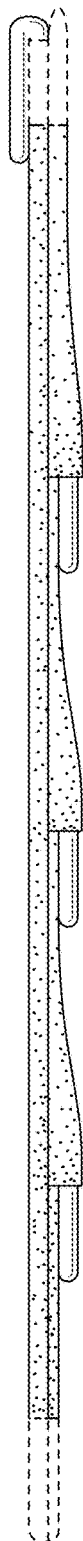

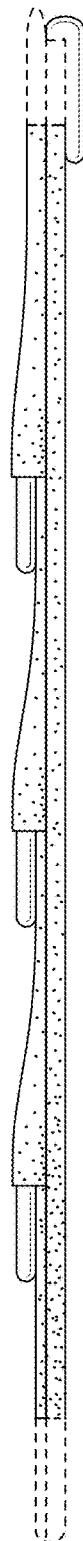

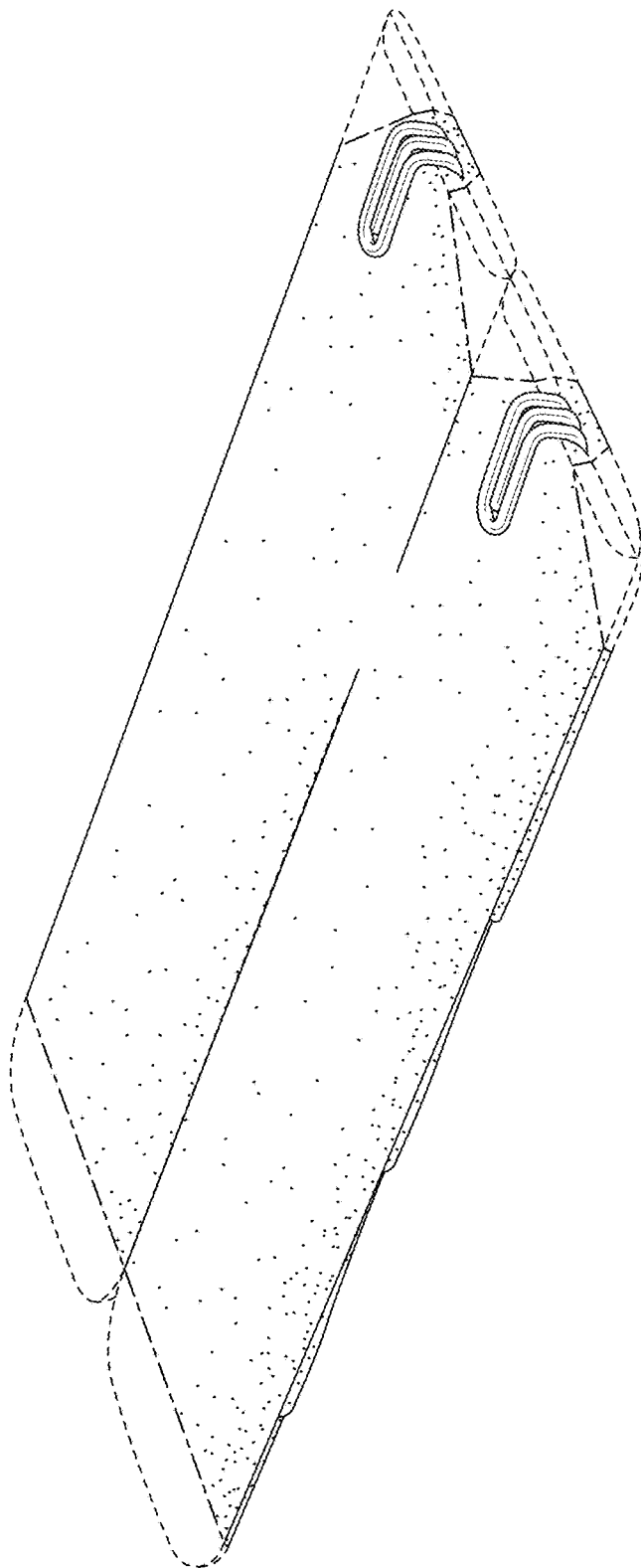

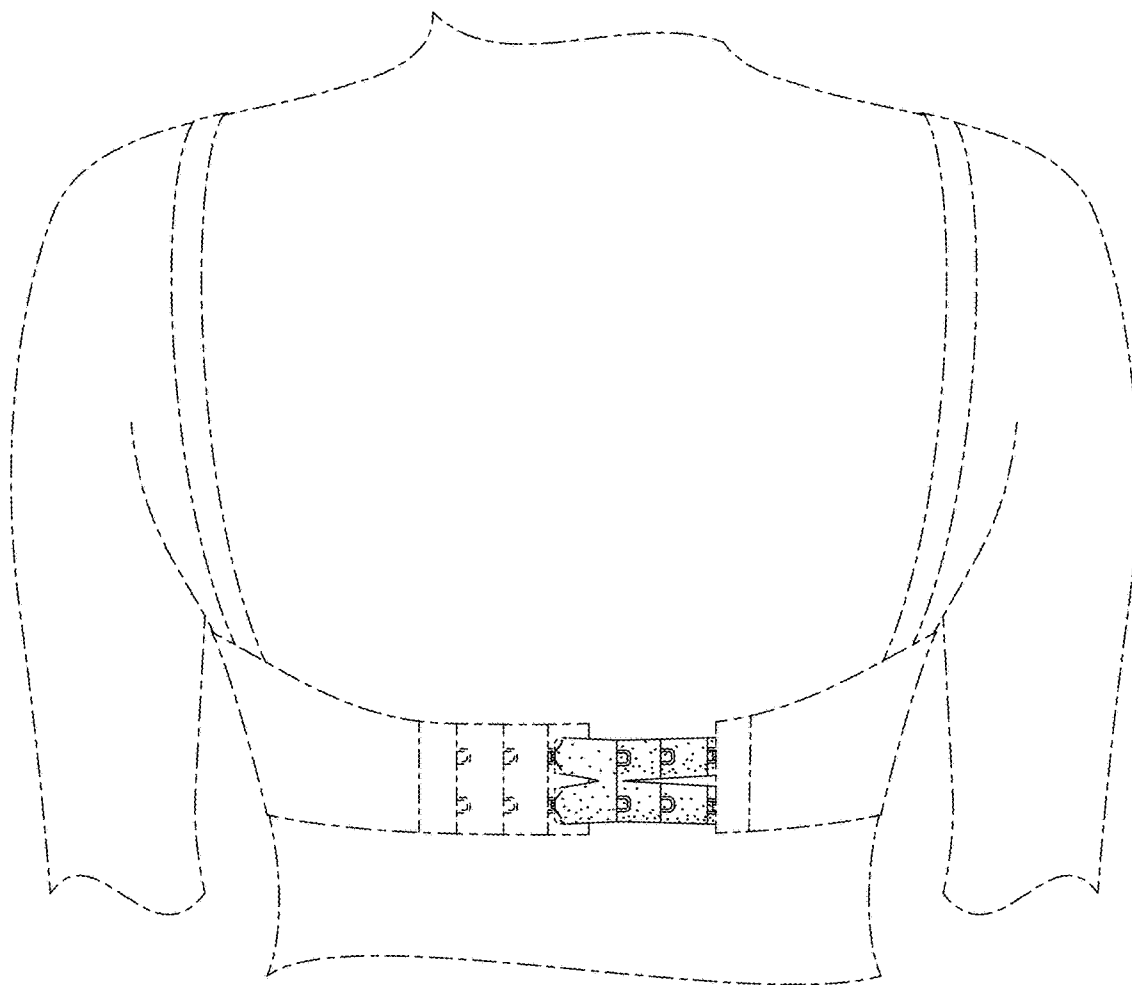
